










VOTER UNIVERSE – JULY 13-16, 2023

Screener survey of 13 statements, asking respondents to rank agreement on a 0-10 scale, identified 72% of American voters as part of America's New Majority.


- Most voters are unaware of Joe Biden's refusal to acknowledge Hunter Biden's four-year-old daughter as his seventh grandchild.
- Once learning of this, nearly 7-in-10 voters think Joe Biden should acknowledge Hunter Biden's four-year-old daughter as his granddaughter.
- Voters are most likely to say knowing the story makes them believe Joe Biden is "out of touch."
- 28% of swing voters say Joe Biden's refusal to acknowledge the girl as his granddaughter makes them "much less likely" to vote for him in 2024.






NEARLY 7-IN-10 VOTERS THINK JOE BIDEN SHOULD ACKNOWLEDGE HIS GRANDAUGHTER




28% OF SWING VOTERS "MUCH LESS LIKELY" TO VOTE FOR JOE BIDEN


"Does knowing that President Joe Biden refuses to acknowledge Navy as his granddaughter make you more likely or less likely to vote for him in 2024?"

Methodology

Mclaughlin & Associates partnered with Gingrich360 to conduct a national survey for America's New Majority Project. This national survey was conducted among 2,000 registered voters between July 13-16, 2023.

All interviews were conducted online. Survey invitations were distributed randomly within predetermined geographic units. These units were structured to correlate with actual general election turnout.

The sample of 2,000 registered voters has an accuracy of +/- 2.2% at a 95% confidence interval. The numbers in this presentation have been rounded and may not equal 100%.
