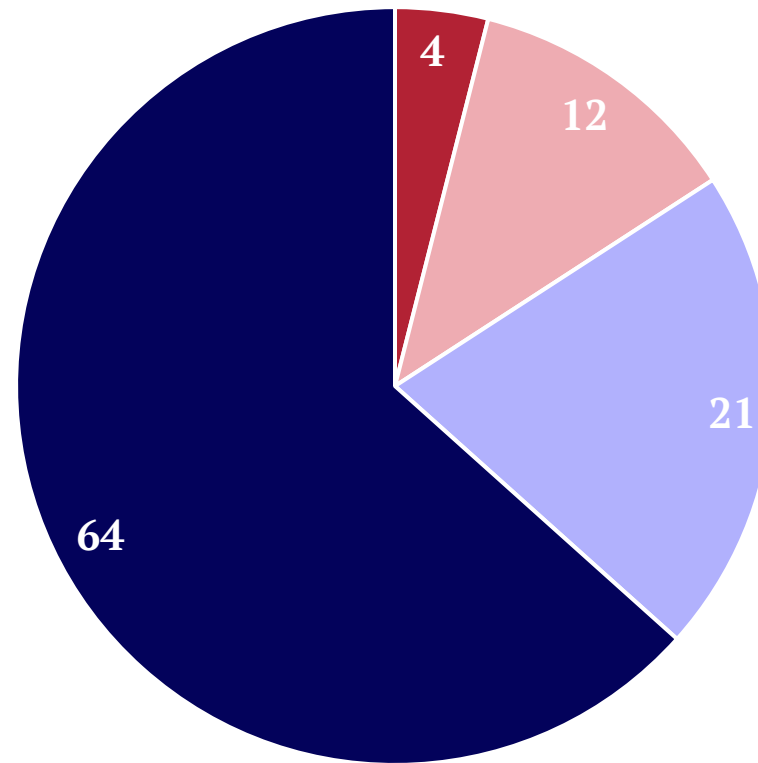


KEY TAKEAWAYS

- Most say they have heard nothing about the Republican “Reverse the Curse” budget plan.
- Many policies in the Republican “Reverse the Curse” budget plan are supported by two-thirds or more voters, particularly policies that strengthen Medicare without cutting benefits, preventing scheduled tax increases, and funding for border security.
- However, most voters are skeptical that these policies will get done, showing that credibility may be a bigger obstacle than policy popularity for the House GOP.
- Context – Both parties have a credibility problem. The number of Americans who say the country is on the wrong track reached a new high in this survey, and previous surveys show that most Americans believe both parties are focused on the wrong things.

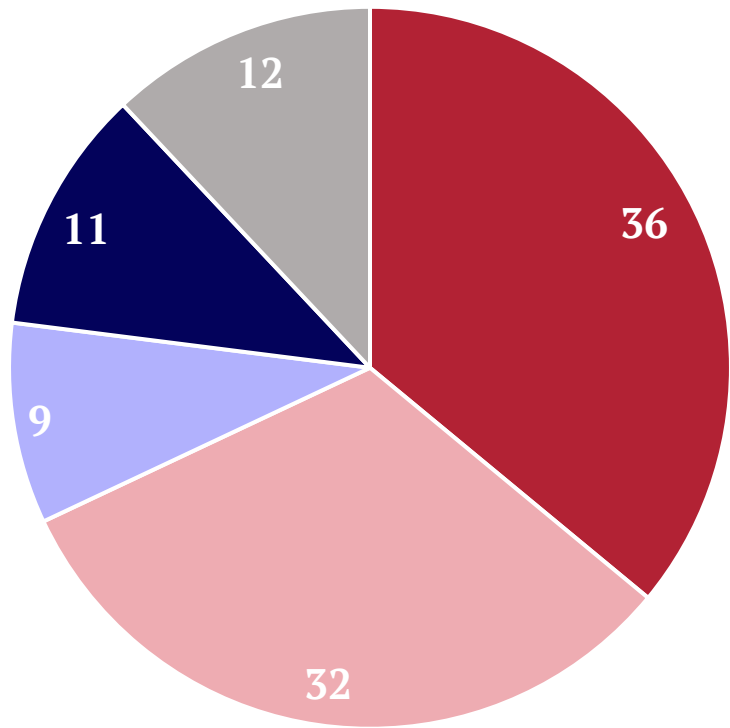

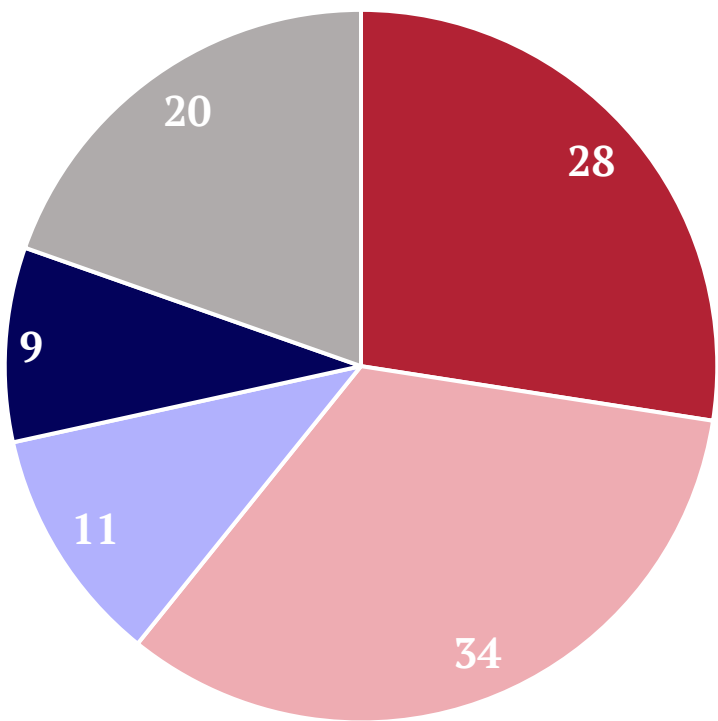

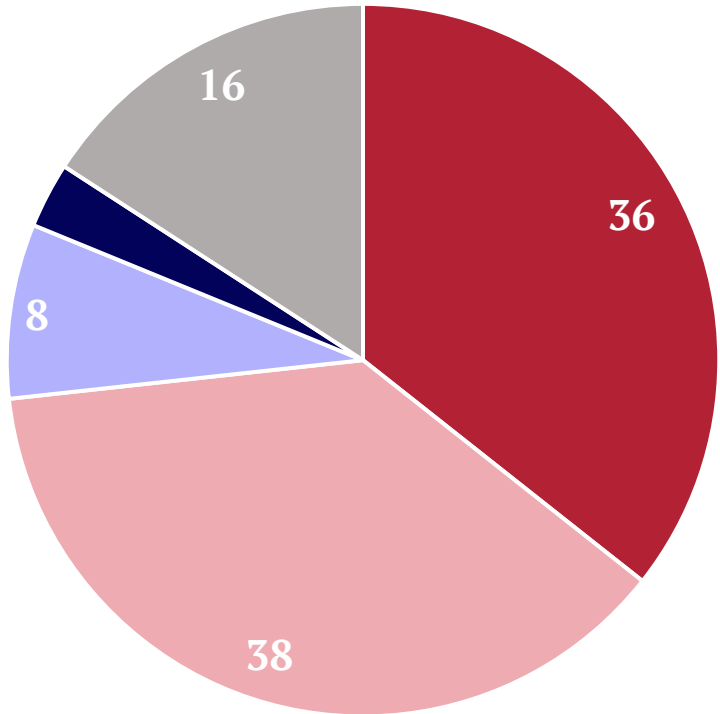
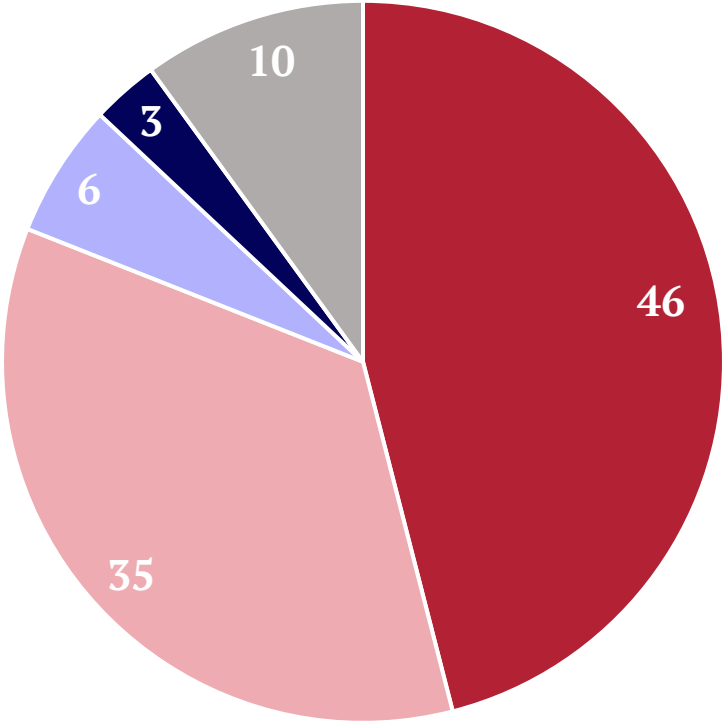

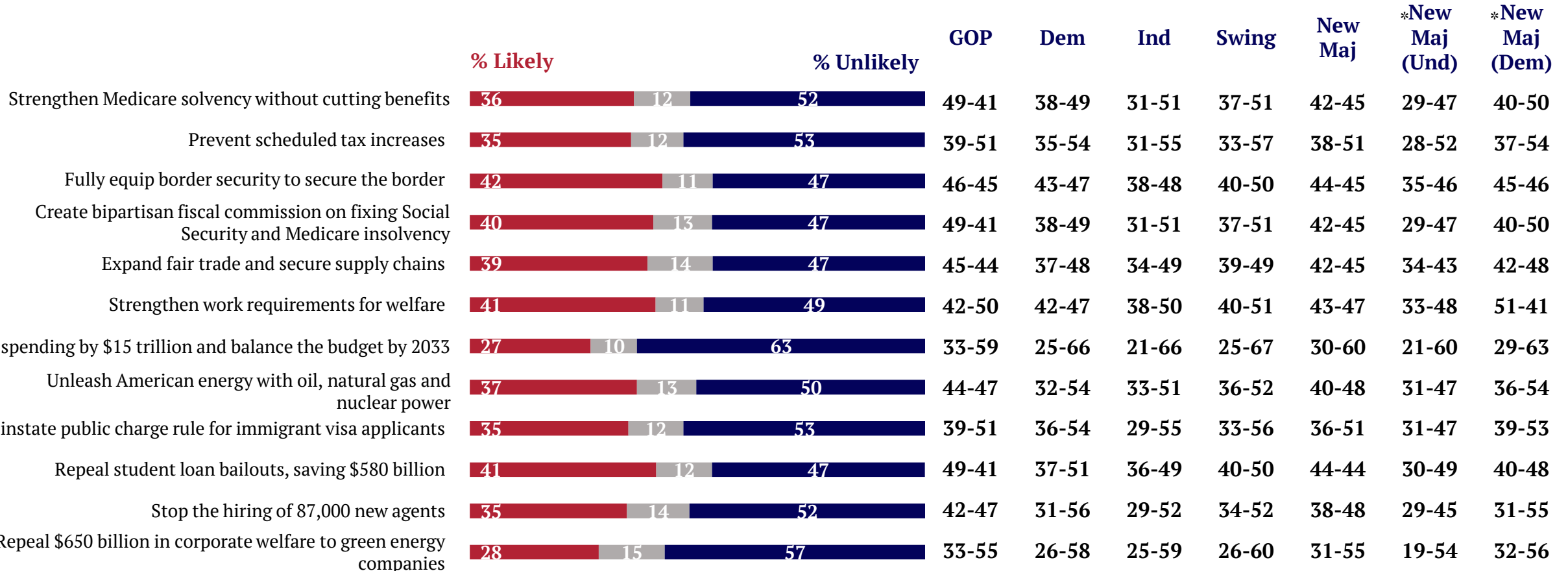

For each of the policies in the Republican “Reverse the Curse” budget plan, how likely is it that each one will get done?

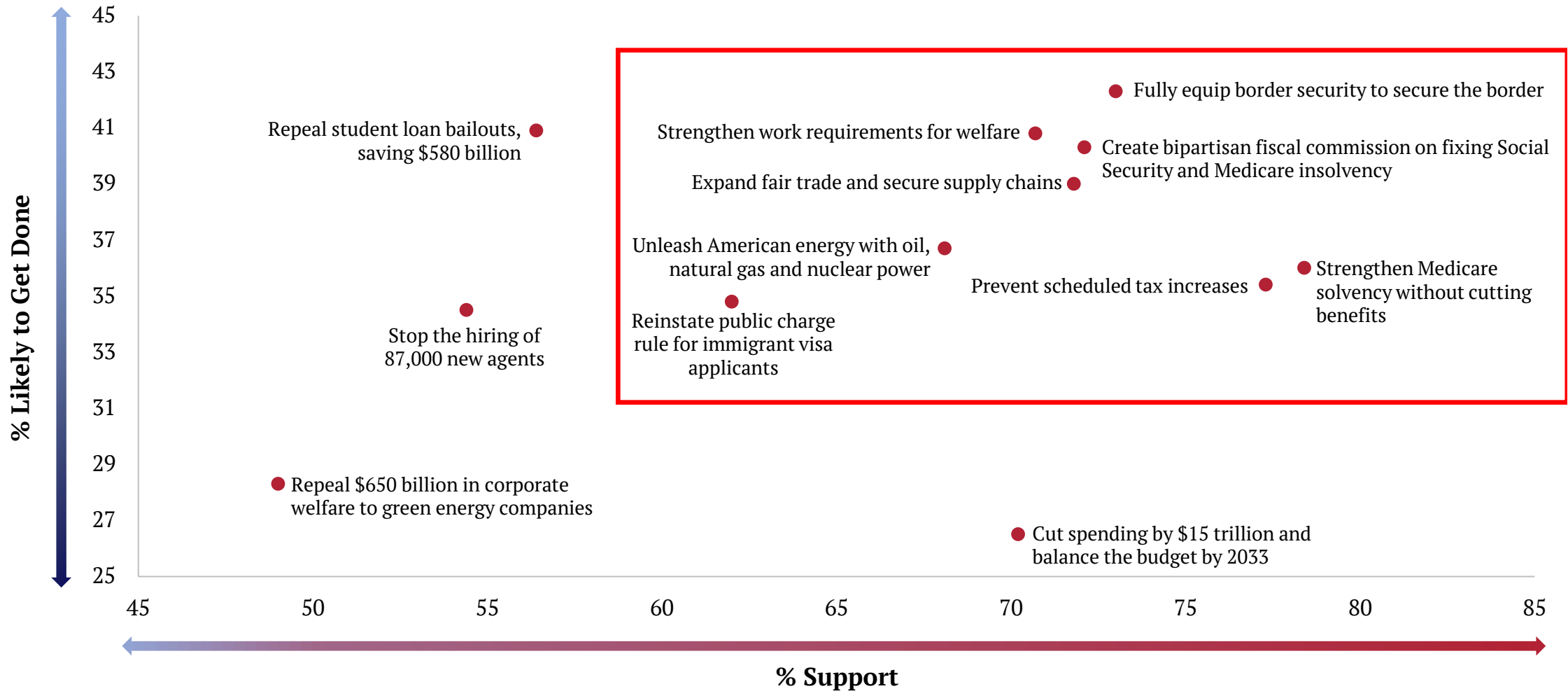

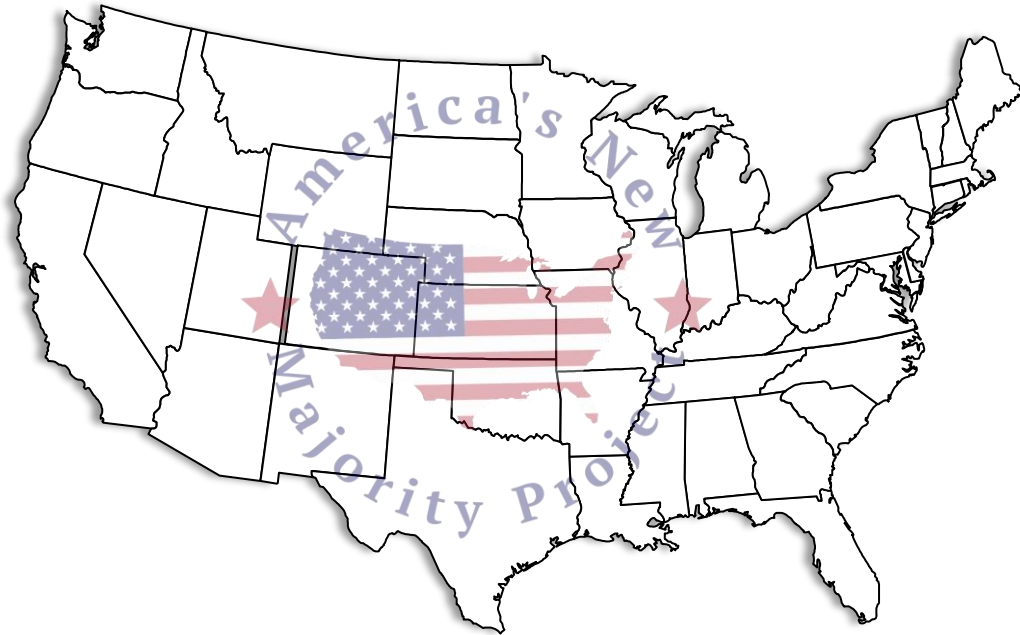


Methodology

Mclaughlin & Associates partnered with Gingrich360 to conduct a national survey for America's New Majority Project. This national survey was conducted among 2,000 registered voters between September 28 and October 1, 2023.

All interviews were conducted online. Survey invitations were distributed randomly within predetermined geographic units. These units were structured to correlate with actual general election turnout.

The sample of 2,000 registered voters has an accuracy of +/- 2.2% at a 95% confidence interval. The numbers in this presentation have been rounded and may not equal 100%.

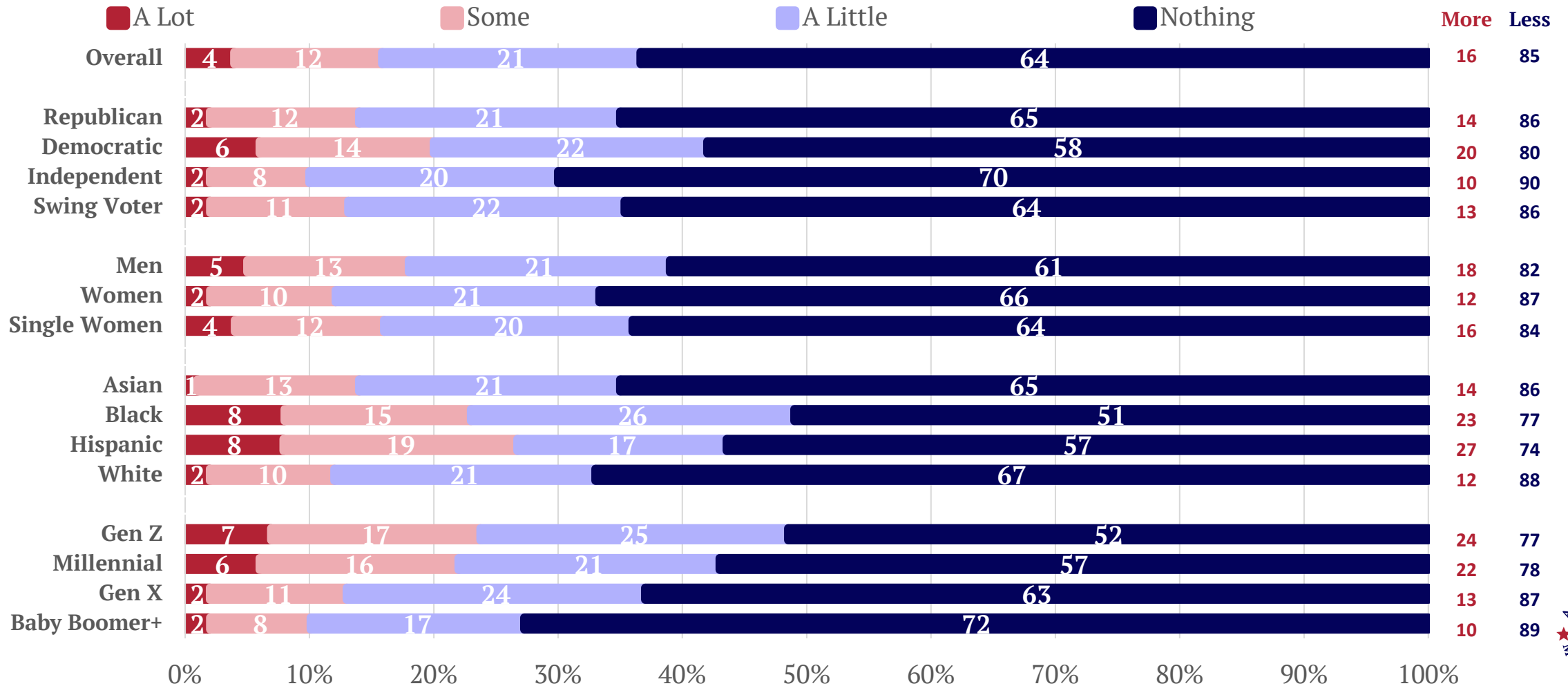

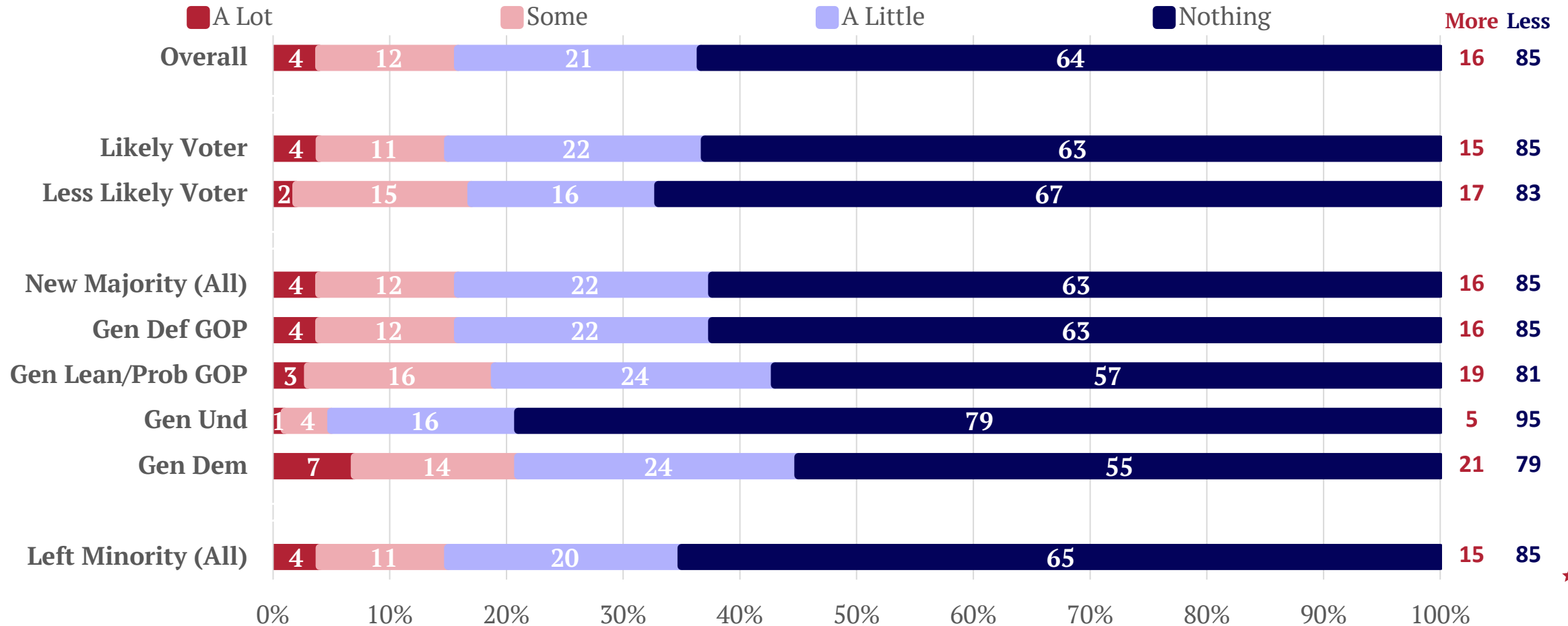

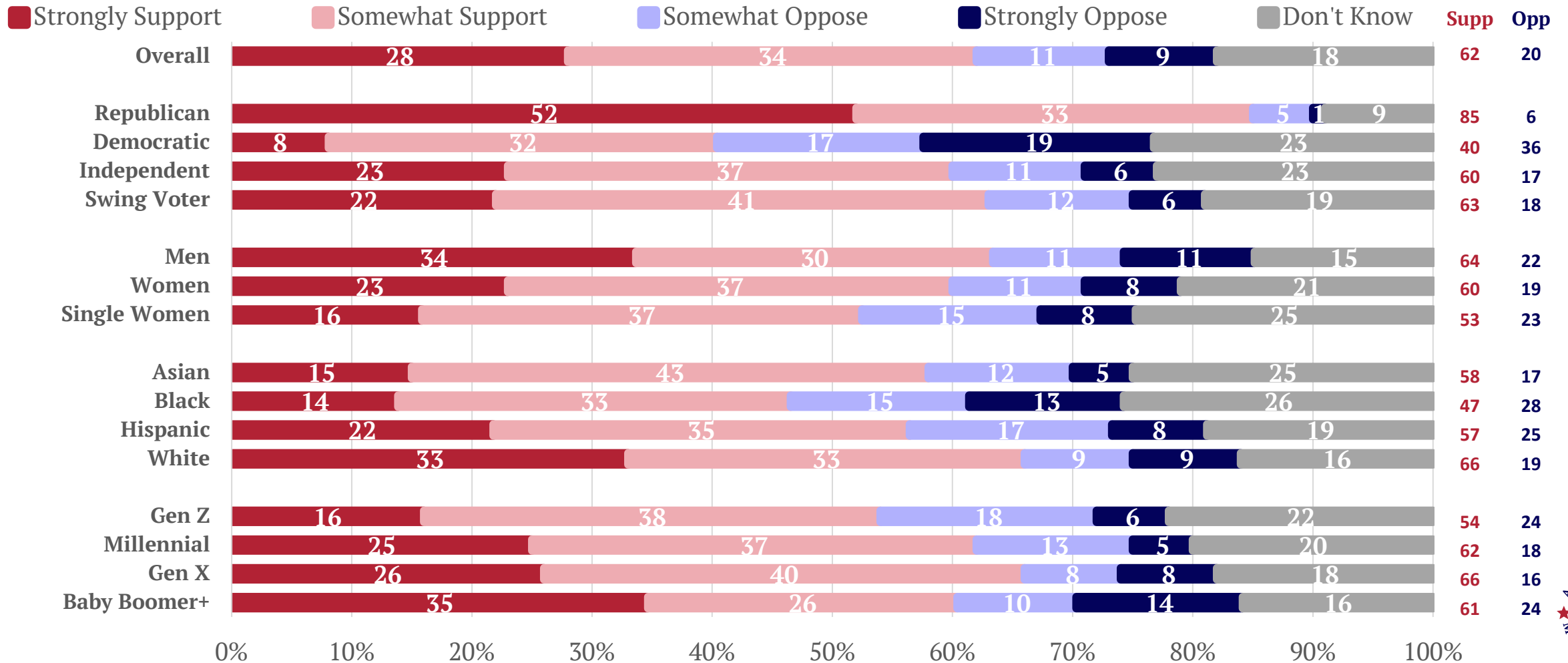

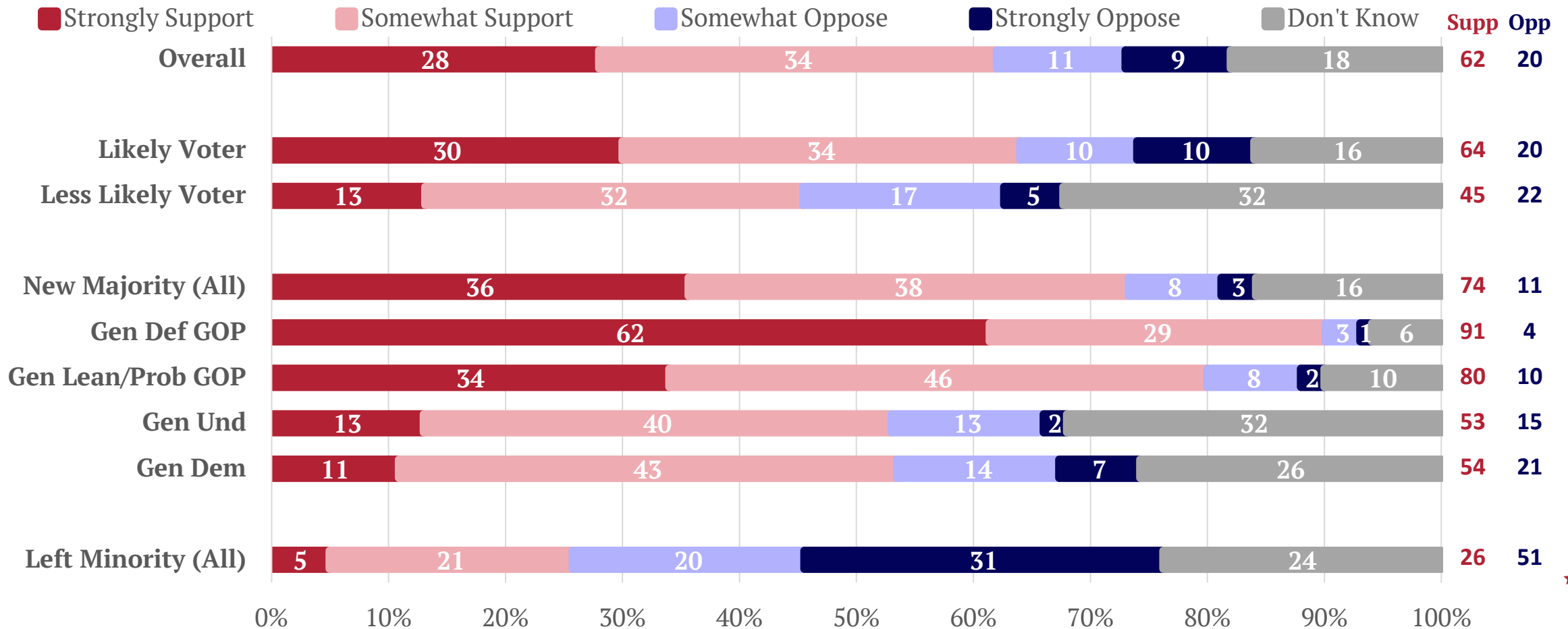

“Would you support or oppose a Republican budget plan, which would reduce the deficit by \$16 trillion dollars and balance the budget in 10 years?”



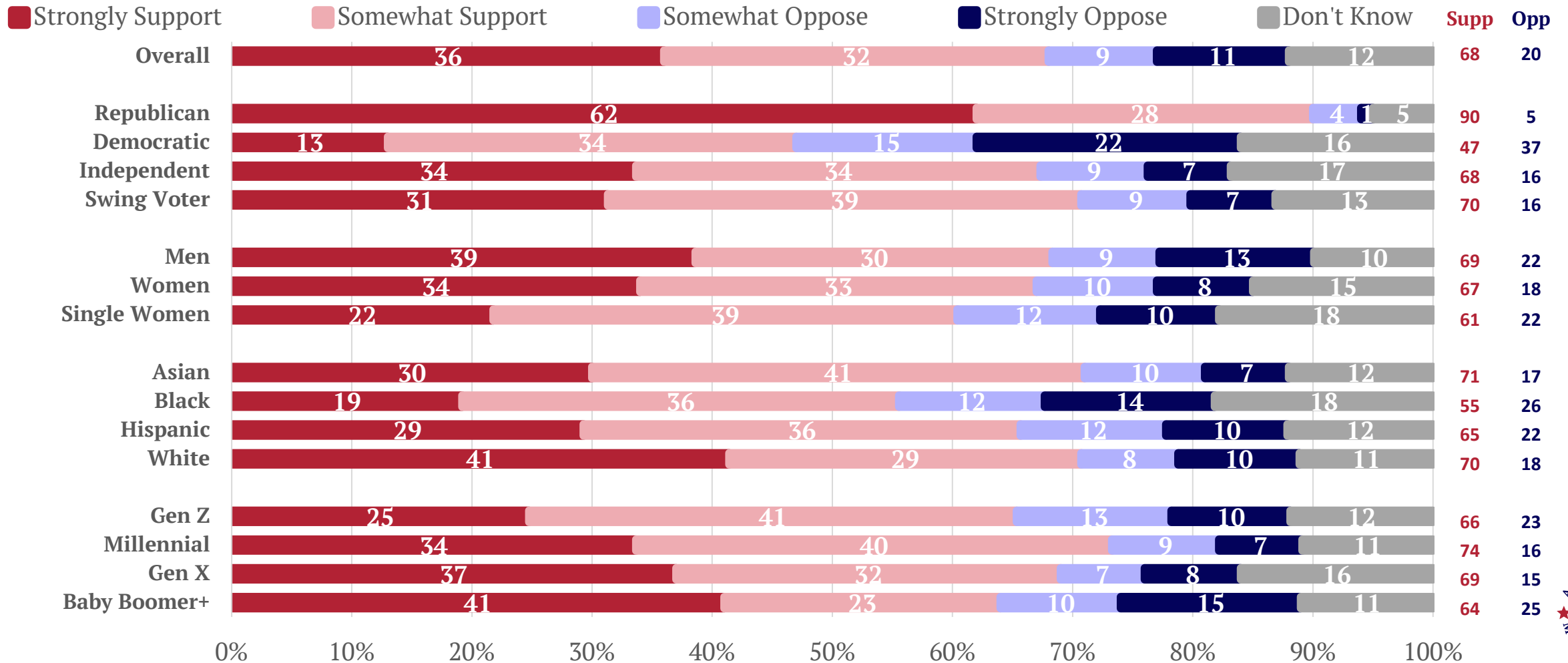

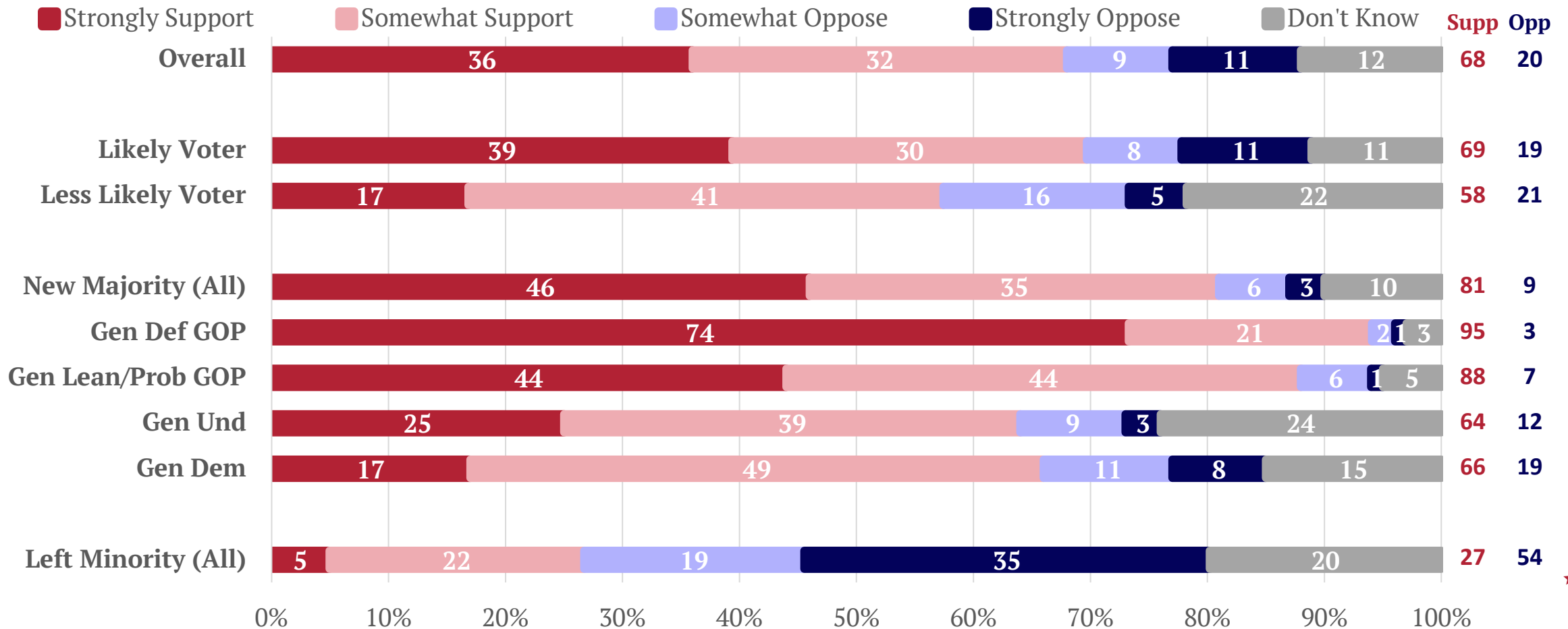

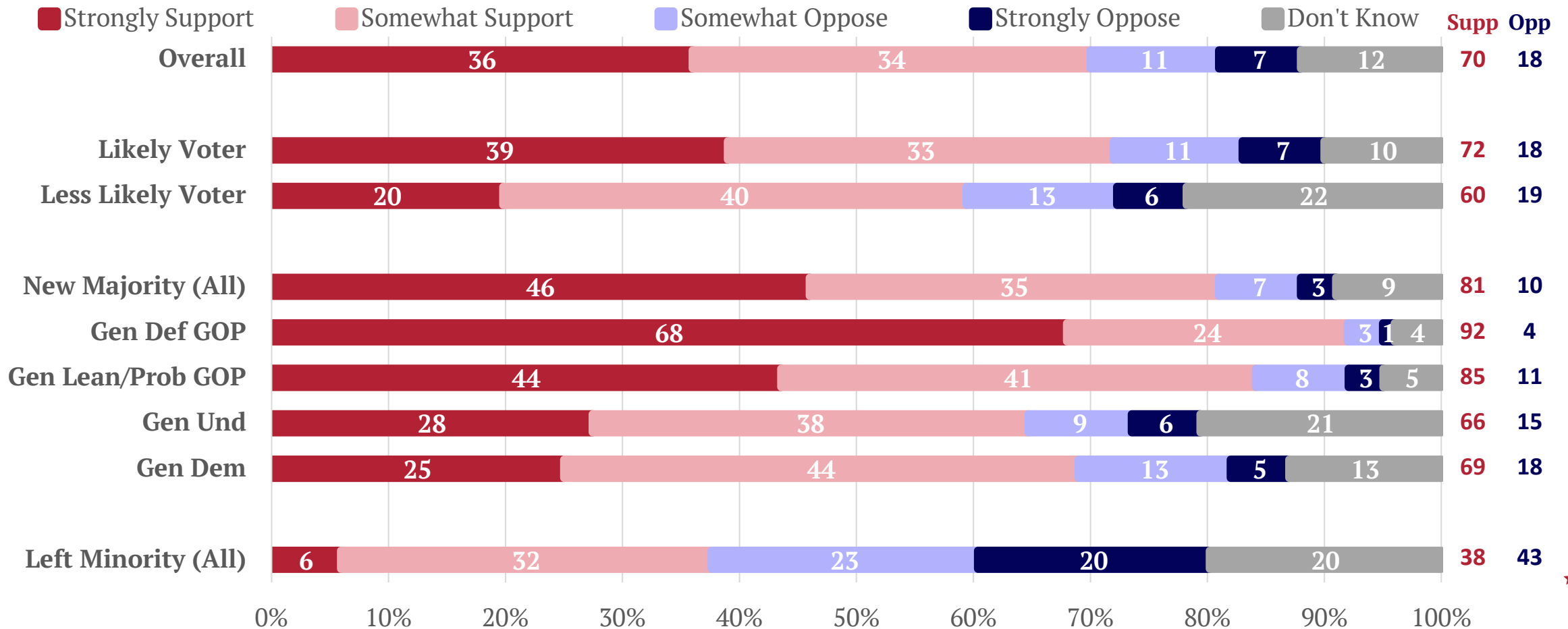

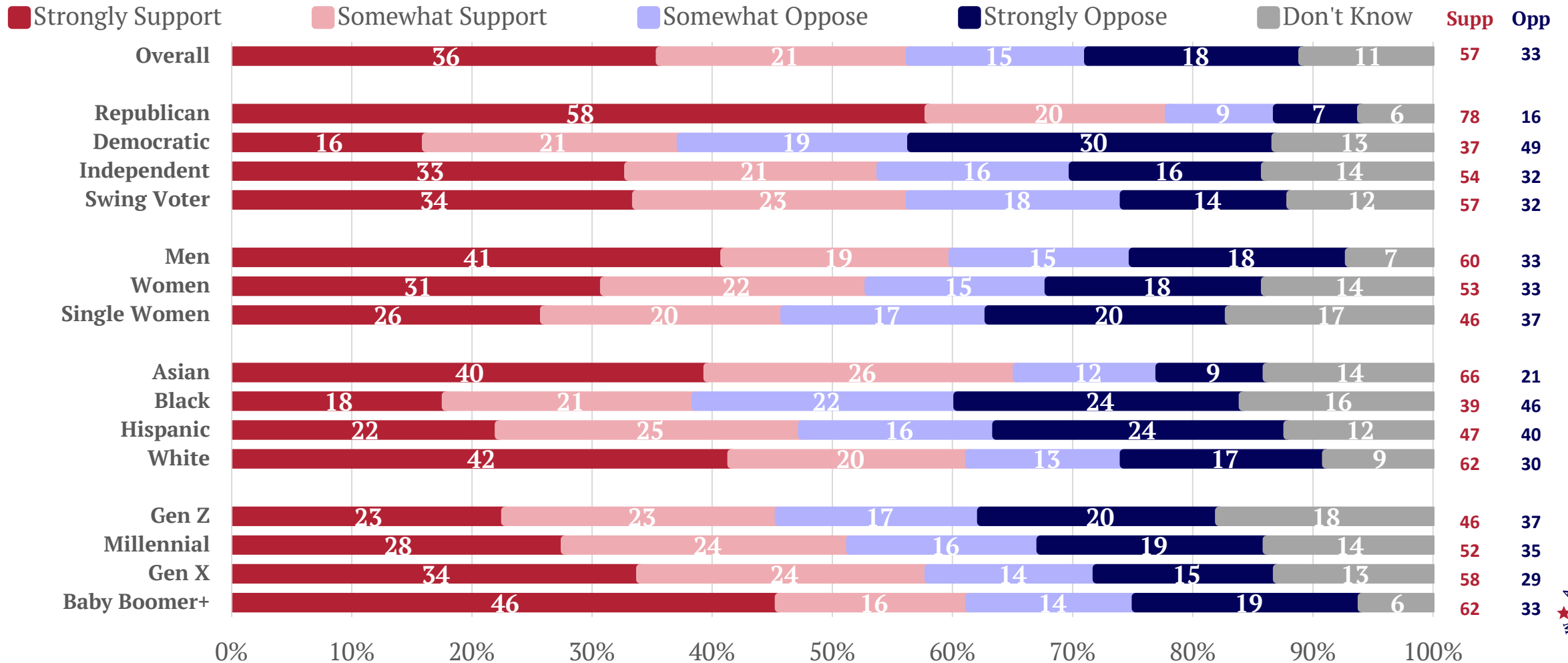
